NETL-RUA Energy Internship Program – Details

➤ Intern Eligibility

- Student at RUA University
- U.S. citizen
- 18 years of age
- GPA of 3.0
- Enrolled in STEM – related discipline



➤ Program Quick Facts

- Research performed at university; collaboration with NETL staff strongly encouraged
- PI selects candidate
- Intern delivers presentation/report at conclusion of internship



Energy Internship Program Key Facts

- **Interns will work on existing NETL-RUA research projects**
- **Funding and number of interns will be determined by ORD Director**

Energy Internship Program Process

- **CALs, FALs, & TC's nominate research projects**
- **ORD Director selects final projects**
- **Criteria for project selection:**
 - Research progress & results to date
 - Potential impact of research
 - Degree of collaboration between NETL & University

Timeline

- **3/5/13** Announce at Spring Mtg.
- **March** Projects identified & submitted to ORD Dir. for selection
PI notified of project selection
- **April** PI selects intern
- **May-August** Internship
