

Potentially Duplicative Funding Response – Adaptable Grid Project

At the time of application to the Grid Resilience and Innovations Partnerships Smart Grid Grant, OG&E has no other active awards of federal funds that would overlap with the activities set forth in this FOA (Funding Opportunity Announcement). All project funds (including recipient cost share and federal funds) will be specifically used for cost items that have been scoped for the projects as described and defined in the various application items submitted.

In addition to the Smart Grid Grant (Section 40107), OG&E also plans to submit an application for the Grid Resilience Grant (Section 40101c). While some of the intended project work may be similar between the two grants, the projects are separate and independent from one another, with distinct work schedules and anticipated outcomes.

If OG&E receives any other award of federal funds or activities that potentially overlap with the activities funded under the Department of Energy (DOE) award in the future, we will notify the DOE in writing and state whether project funds have the potential to be used for identical cost items. If there are identical cost items, we will notify the DOE Contracting Officer in writing and eliminate any inappropriate duplication of funding.
