Description:

A9 Information Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), gathering, analysis, data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but and dissemination not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies),

B3.6 Small-scale research

Siting, construction, modification, operation, and decommissioning of facilities for smallscale research and development projects; conventional and development, laboratory laboratory operations (such as preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than 2 years) operations, and pilot projects frequently conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions, provided that construction or modification would be within or contiguous to a previously disturbed or developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible).
