



Foreign National Entrance Requirements

Bring U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) documentation that was provided at the time of the access request or event registration:

This documentation supports our identification requirements and will be scanned into the DOE foreign national record system at time of in-processing.

Acceptable identifications for FNs include:

- REAL ID state driver's license or photo ID
- Unexpired foreign passport with a valid U.S. visa and approved I-94 issued by DHS
- Unexpired Employment Authorization Card (EAD) issued by DHS
- Valid, unexpired Permanent Resident Card (Green Card) issued by DHS or INS

FN visitors/assignees are not permitted access to NETL facilities or personnel without presenting these original documents.

A Social Security Card is not an acceptable form of identification. REAL ID requirements must be followed.

FN visitors/assignees may not bring a camera or any recording devices such as laptops, thumb drives, ipods, etc., as these items are not permitted on site.

Photocopies of USCIS documents cannot be used in place of the original(s).

Please leave ample time for security to review identification and inspect vehicles.

Real ID Requirements

IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR NETL VISITOR SITE ENTRY:

As of May 7, 2025, a valid REAL ID state driver's license or photo ID is required for U.S. citizen site entry.

Other acceptable valid REAL ID compliant identification that will permit site entry:

- U.S. or foreign passport or passport card
- HSPD-12 PIV card
- U.S. Department of Defense ID
- State Issued Enhanced Driver's License
- Global Entry Card
- Canadian Provincial DL / Indian NACC
- Employment Authorization Document (I-766)
- Permanent Resident Card
- DHS Trusted Traveler Card
- Border Crossing Card
- Federally Recognized Tribal Issued Photo ID
- Transportation Worker ID Credential
- U.S. Merchant Mariner Credential
- School or University ID (under age 18)
