Mrs. Monica Marks serves as the Director for the Office of Departmental Vetting and Assistance (EH-35) within the Office of Environment, Health, Safety and Security at the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE). In this capacity, she is responsible for the Department-wide implementation of Personnel Vetting Policy, ensuring adherence to Trusted Workforce requirements for national security, non-sensitive public trust, and low-risk populations across the agency. Her office also oversees the Professional Adjudication Training Certification Program, Administrative Review (the Department's Due Process), Congressional Inquiries, Quality Assurance, Field Assistance, and Clearance Automation. Furthermore, Monica is responsible for the implementation of national policies established by the Office of Personnel Management, the Office of the Director of National Intelligence, and the White House, including the Office of Management and Budget's Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004.

With over 22 years of dedicated service to the DOE across various security disciplines, Monica brings a wealth of experience. She previously held the role of Senior Security Specialist, where she coordinated the enrollment of over 100,000 national security personnel into continuous vetting capabilities. Her diverse background at the DOE also includes impactful roles as a Central Alarm Station Operator for the DOE Headquarters Protective Force, a Program Analyst for the National Nuclear Security Administration, and a Security Assistant in the Office of Headquarters Security Operations.
